Dear Sir/Madam,

You will be aware that at a Public Meeting held in May of last year a small Committee was set up to obtain information regarding the possibility of establishing a Community Centre in Hagley.

The Parish Council is now arranging a further Public Meeting to be held on the 4TH FEBRUARY, 1963, at 8.30 p.m. at PARK ROAD SCHOOL, to receive a report from the Committee, and to consider the recommendation that a Community Association be formed.

A Community Association is not just another organisation, but a means whereby representatives of the Local Authorities and of all the groups and societies in the neighbourhood can join together with the individual residents in a common effort to improve the amenities of the district, and to provide in its Community Centre a meeting place with facilities for all sorts of worth-while activities, as well as a focal point for neighbourhood activities and service. A Community Association is non-profit making, non-sectarian and non-party-political, and the management of its affairs will be in the hands of a council elected by the societies and individual members themselves.

If the Association is to achieve its objects it is vitally important that it should be as fully representative as possible, and it is hoped that the majority of societies and organisations and a great many of the people living in Hagley will give it their support. It is not proposed at this stage to charge anything in the way of Affiliation or Membership fees but if you are interested and willing to support the Association, you are asked to fill in and return the attached form.

The future of the Association and its Centre rests with you. The Community Centre will belong to the people of Hagley and its success will depend very much on YOUR interest and support. It is hoped, therefore, that you and the members of your household will attend the Meeting.

A suggested plan of the Centre, and the proposed constitution of the Association may be seen at the Library.
