Miss Gertrude Gale, Draper and Postmistress, is mentioned in Kelly's Directory 1912.

She ran the business with her sister. They produced a series of picture postcards of Hagley.

The buildings were demolished in the late 1960s to make way for new shops.

Malcolm Gee opened as a chemist 1970-71. It was then taken over by Mrs Scarborough. She ran the business until her retirement in 2000.



The shop opened in 2001 selling children's clothing. It closed down February 2003.



The shop was refitted and opened as an estate agency in 2003.
