This was a grocery shop and bakery.

It was run by Harry Webb and his son Norman, noted for home-made ice-lollies.

It was later owned by Turners when it became a delicatessen.

Later it became Quality House, grocers and Post Office run by W.A. & R.H.Douglas.



It was taken over by Stourbridge Rolling Mills and demolished to make way for Bakery Court in 1972.
