

115 WORCESTER ROAD

The original building on this site was Rose Cottage. The block of stones on the pavement is part of the old garden wall.

The Midland Bank was the first bank in Hagley being in Station Road in 1928. They moved into these premises before 1940 when it was still a cottage.

Mr Skelding did shoe repairs at the front of the building.

The cottage was demolished in the early 1960s to make way for the new bank.
