

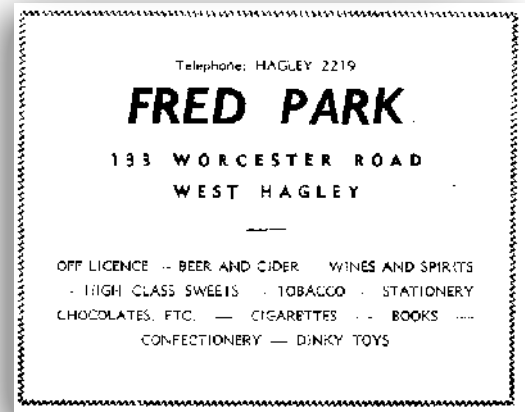
# 133 WORCESTER ROAD

This was originally a sweet shop, the first shop to sell ice cream after WW2 attracting queues of children.

It was known as Bridges in the 1950s and later Fred Park in the 1960s.

It then became The Sweet Shop and Wine Keg run by the Pitchfords and then by Pat Taylor.

It was later taken over by Victoria Wines until 2002 when it became Threshers.
