


By 1940 Mrs Louise White and Mary Roberts had set up the Lyttelton Cafe with its sign of a Hovis loaf backed by a setting sun.

Mrs Roberts baked cakes in the huge oven for sale in the shop.

In the early 1960s Mr & Mrs Woodhouse and their daughter Brenda set up an excellent grocery shop where Brenda specialised in unusual cheeses.

It was then known as The End Shop.

In 1969 the owners of the property, Mr & Mrs Genner, carried on the business for a further year.



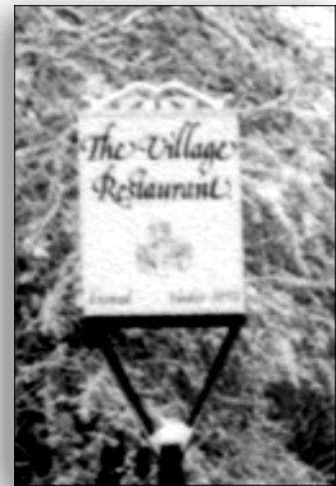
