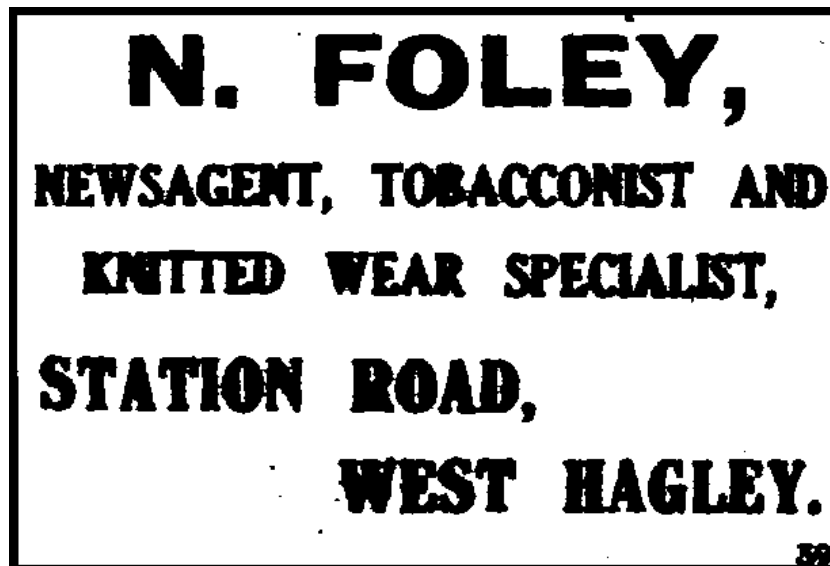


21 STATION ROAD

The land at this address was bought from Charles James Bate by William Foley in 1902.

The Foley family, William and Nancy, and later their son Joseph ran a newsagent's and tobacconist's shop from at least 1912 until it was sold by Joseph in 1932.

Norah Carradine of Colley Gate bought the business for £1000.

For this she raised a mortgage of £600.

Harold Chivers became an associate with her in 1935 and obtained a mortgage of £600.

By 1939 only Harold Chivers is mentioned when he is joined by W.S.Gregory who raised a mortgage of £525 but this was short lived.

David and Marion Carradine ran the business until 1942.

In 1942 the business was sold by Harold Chivers to Beatrice Gertrude Bridgewater and Annie Burns.

They continued the business until the premises were sold to Brian Melvyn Morgan in 1969.
