

## 5 STATION ROAD

From at least 1912 this has been a grocer's shop.

At first it was run by John Edwin Gale then by Joseph Gale until 1924.

It then became Strickley Ltd run by Alf, Miss Strickley and their sister Mrs Richardson.

It was noted for the smell of freshly ground coffee and the bicycle on which the goods were delivered.

In 1969 the Crockets took over the shop.

The shop was badly damaged by fire for the second time in three weeks.

Mr & Mrs Price took over for a short period until the shop was refitted and opened as a dress shop by Derry in 1970.



Note the bus stop here. The bus used to run as far as Hoarstone in Sweetpool Lane.



Derry closed down at the end of 1999.

Debut opened as a dress shop January 2000.
