This was once the home of Dr Millar-Smith and later Dr Gosling and Dr Hansell.



In the late 1950s or early 1960s it became Wrenson's Grocery. It later changed to LO COST.



For a short time it was taken over by Spar.



In 1996 it was opened as King's of Hagley.

The tea rooms at the rear were known as Tea For Two run by Angela & Paul Fellows.
